Intervention Procedures in Case of Suspected Violence to a Minor by Third Parties

(e.g. volunteers, staff members, or other individuals in contact with the child)

If you suspect that a minor:

- 1) Is experiencing violence causing harm to health (e.g. illness or bodily injury), sexual abuse, and/or their life is in danger:
 - a) Ensure the safety of the minor and ensure they are separated from the person suspected of abuse;
 - b) Notify the Police by calling 112 or 997. For that, provide your personal details, the minor's details, details of the suspected perpetrator, and any other known facts about the incident.
- 2) Has fallen victim to other types of criminal acts:
 - a) Ensure the safety of the minor and ensure they are separated from the person suspected of abuse;
 - b) Inform the Police or Public Prosecutor's Office in writing by submitting a suspected crime notification.

Note: The notification may be addressed to the nearest law enforcement unit. It should include your personal details, the minor's details, and the suspected person's details, as well as any other known facts. Describe the incident in detail and provide information about anyone who may have knowledge of the incident. The notification may also be submitted anonymously, but providing your data will allow the authorities to obtain the necessary information more efficiently.

- 3) Is experiencing a non-recurring other type of physical violence (e.g. spanking, pushing, shoving) or psychological violence (e.g. humiliation, discrimination, ridicule):
 - a) ensure the safety of the minor and ensure that they are separated from the person suspected of abuse;
 - b) Inform the Organizer of the event about the incident.
- 4) Is experiencing other concerning disturbing behaviours

(e.g. yelling, inappropriate comments):

- a) Ensure the safety of the minor and separate ensure they are separated from the person suspected of abuse;
